With all of Luca's health concerns, we are happy to share that the paediatrician is happy with how Luca is currently 'tracking'. Whilst she'd love him to bulk up a bit more, we were all relieved when his latest blood test came back clear. We are trying to get as much food into him as possible, but we are thankful that he is developing well. He is generally a very happy, content child who loves to charm onlookers with his adorable smile. Anna's gregarious, extroverted nature did her well on our

travels. She was happy to meet new people and see new sights at each stop along the way. She particularly enjoyed all the

time she got to play in the water, especially daily trips to the beach when we were in Yamba. It was a long time away though, and by the end, even she was asking, "Can we go home now?". She was very excited to dive back into her toys and dress ups when we finally arrived back in Sydney.



When ARE you leaving?

As we have travelled and shared, one question always comes up. When are you planning on leaving? And the answer is always the same. When we have 100% of our support raised and only God knows when that will be. As you may already know, we are reliant on the support and generosity of churches and individuals to make it possible to be able to minister full time in Romania. In short, we are not able to leave Australia until 100% of our monthly support is pledged.

Since the beginning of the year some more individuals have come on board, so we are currently sitting on 57% at the moment. In the last prayer letter we shared that we were hoping to return by April, as ECM is holding their biennial conference in Spain in April. Unfortunately, we have had to give up that idea as our support levels are not high enough to be depart by April. Once our support hits 80% we are able to book tickets and prepare to leave, trusting that by the time we leave, our support will be at 100%.
